What do we do well?



Our state test scores rank us at the top of all Lee County Schools:

- Elementary schools rank #1 and #2 out of 60 schools.
  - Middle School ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> out of 29 middle schools.
  - Oasis High School ranks 4<sup>th</sup> out of 23 high schools and ranks in the top 2% of high schools (graduating with AICE diplomas) in the nation according to US News and World Reports.\*

## Reasons for success

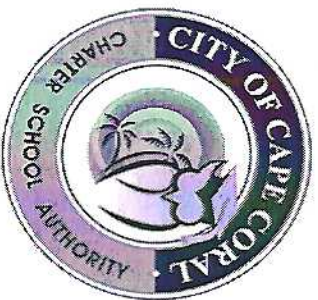


- Students matriculate from Kindergarten to 12 grade (83%)

Re-branding of school identity:

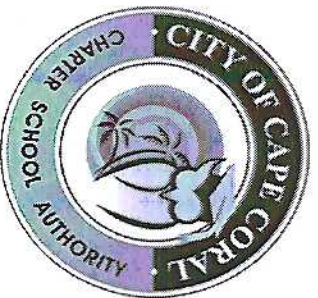
- Our Vision and Mission must come to life

## Transportation



Re-routed all bus routes according to:

- residences on file
- for better coverage of most of the City's sectors (depot stops)
- timeliness
- cost efficiency
- Agreement with LCSC and City of Cape Coral to align with Districts semi-permanent bus stops for safety.
- Added 4 new routes according to demand

## Transportation

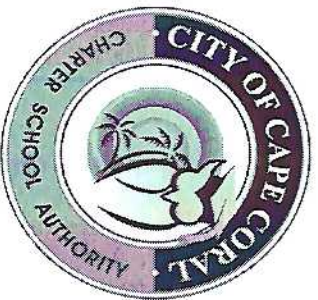


- 20 buses
- 17 drivers
- 68 routes per day
- 842 stops per day, 4210 stops per week
- 1650 assigned students to buses



# The CSA System

## Athletic Fields



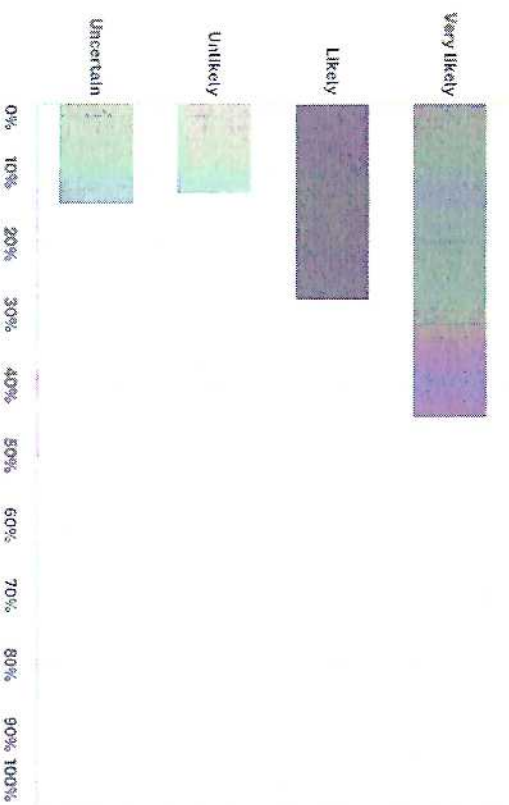
- Renovation of existing football field proposal price \$134,000
- NFL Foundation Grassroots Program; A Community Football Fields Program Grant
- The Ferguson Group grant writers
- Matching grants up to \$100,000 using natural grass/sod surfaces
- Matching grants for up to \$50,000 capital improvements (bleachers, lights, field house)



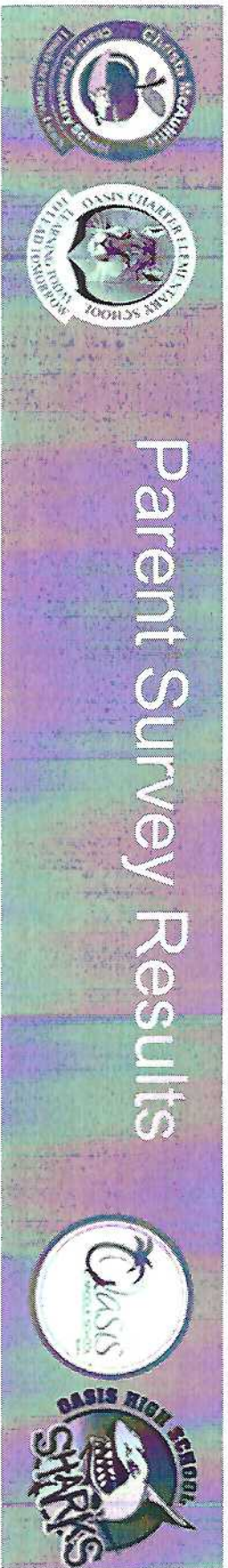

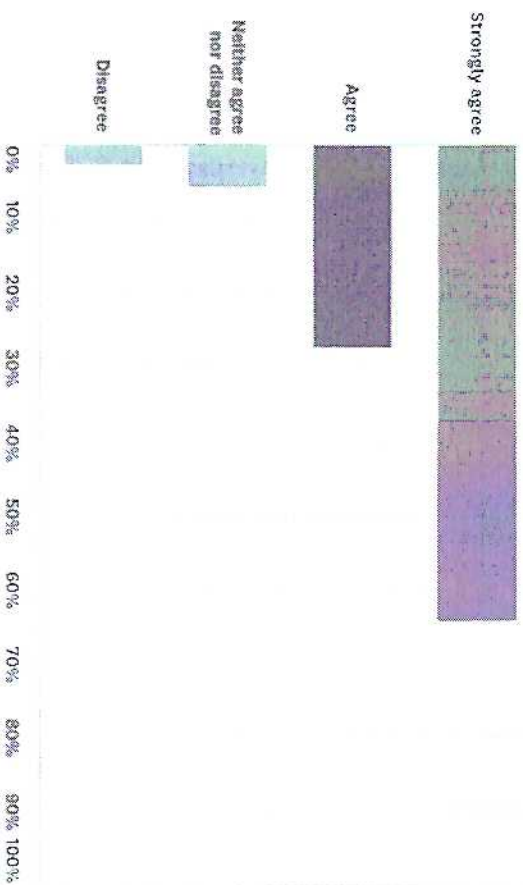
Q2 What is the likelihood that your child will matriculate through 12th grade in our school system?







Q3 My child's teachers are qualified, caring, and committed to excellence in the classroom.



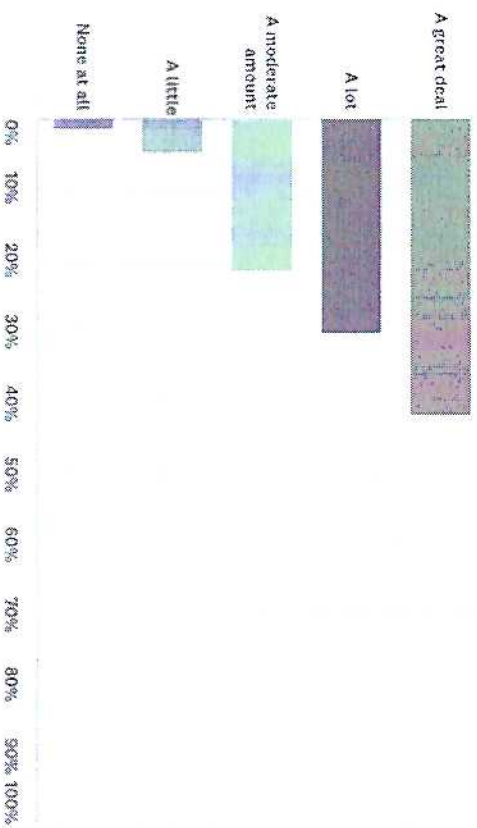

Q5 The school informs me of the system's yearly expectations, performance and achievement goals.



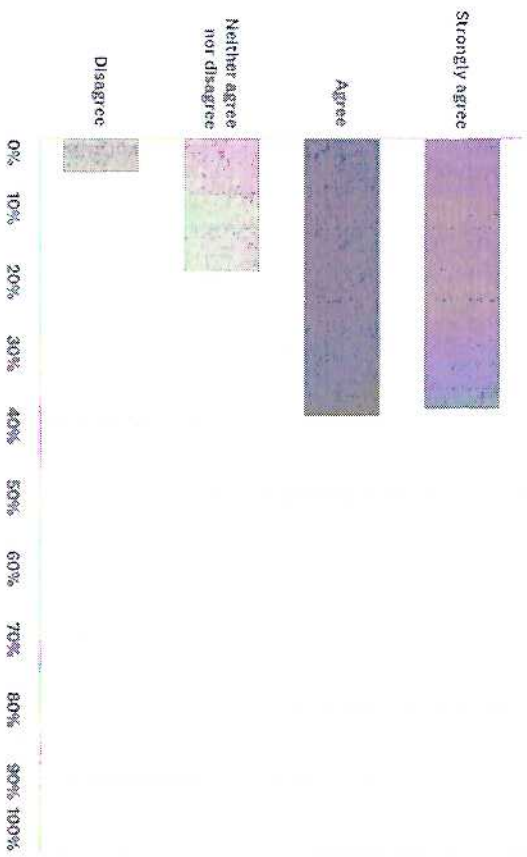

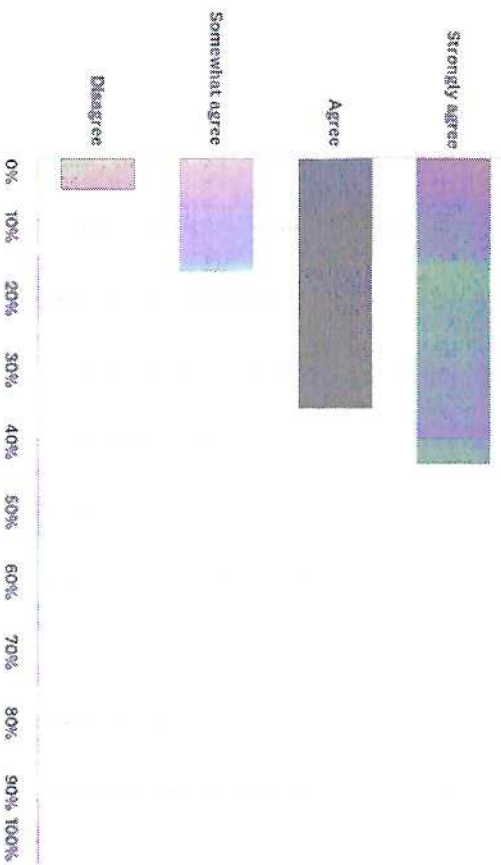


Q6 My child's teachers meet his/her learning needs by individualizing instruction.





Q7 My child's teachers keep me informed regularly of how my child is being assessed and graded.



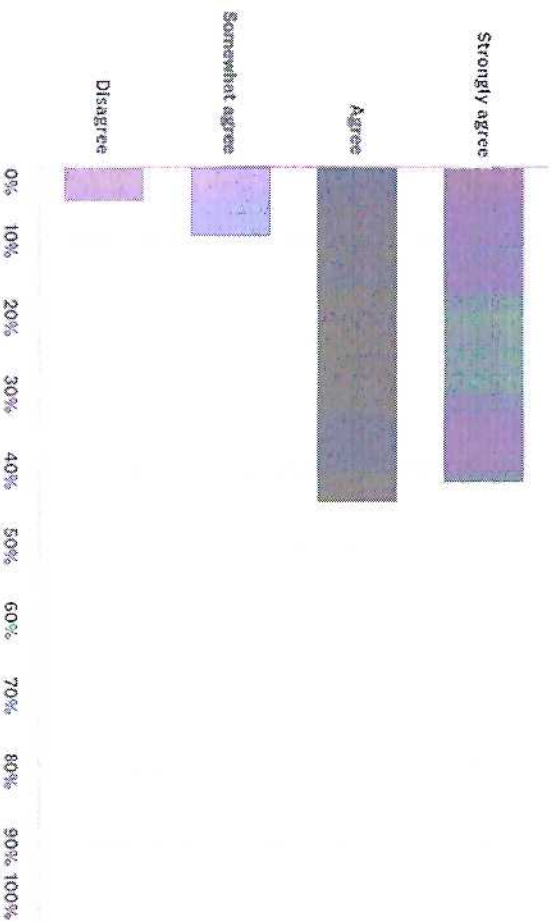

Q8 The curricular programs at our schools are meeting my child's academic needs.

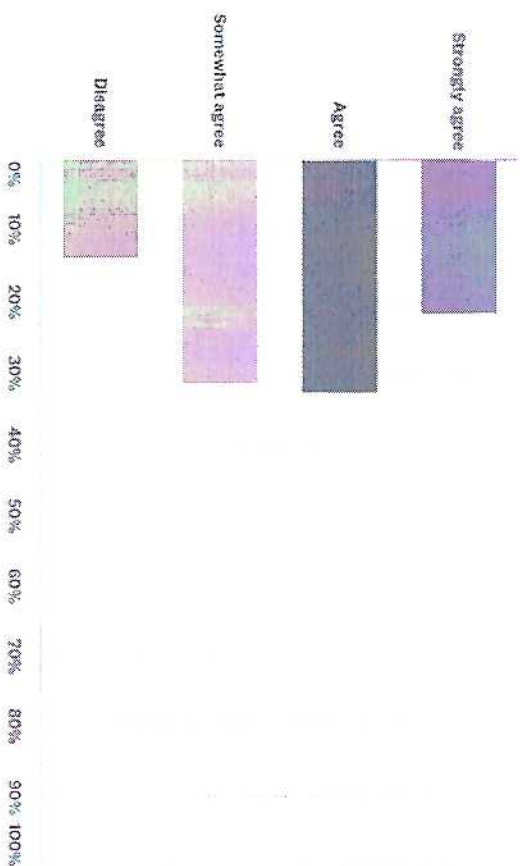

Q9 Our school provides opportunities for students to participate in extra curricular programs, including sports, and other activities that interest them.



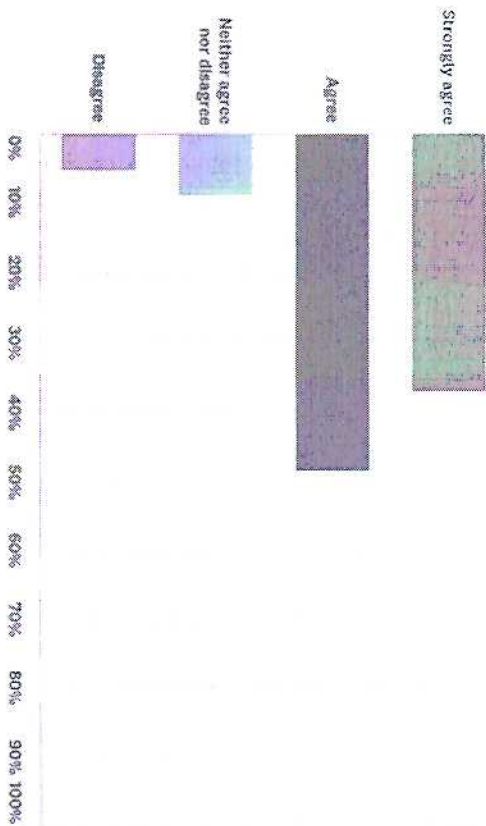


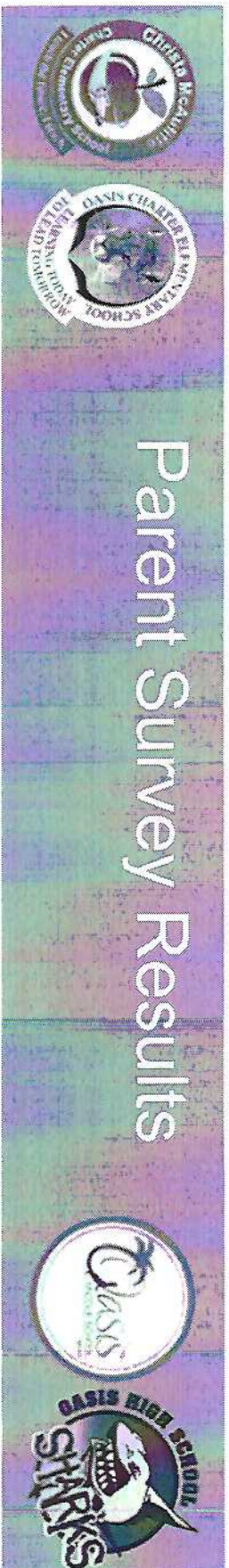

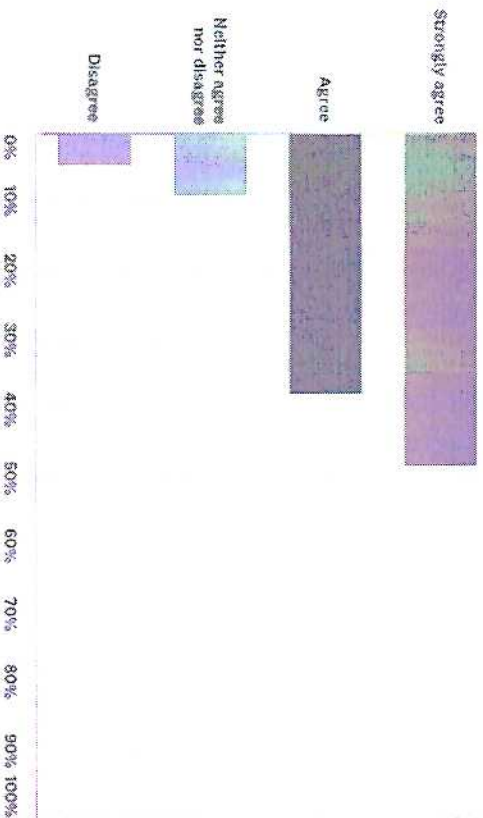
Q11 Our school provides up-to-date resources and technology in order to assist my child's learning.

Q12 Current safety and security initiatives keep my child safe while attending school.



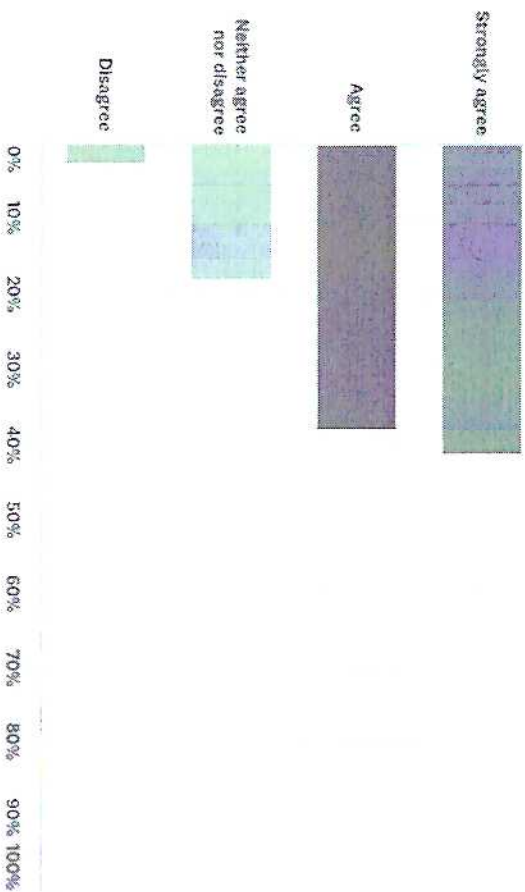

Q13 My child is successfully prepared for the next school year.

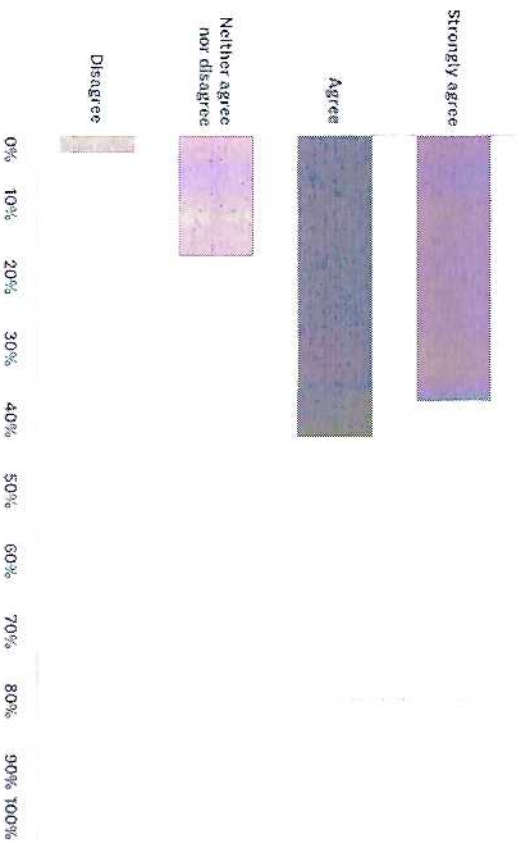

Q17 Do you believe the City's Charter School System fulfills its Vision Statement to empower students to become independent, responsible life-long learners?



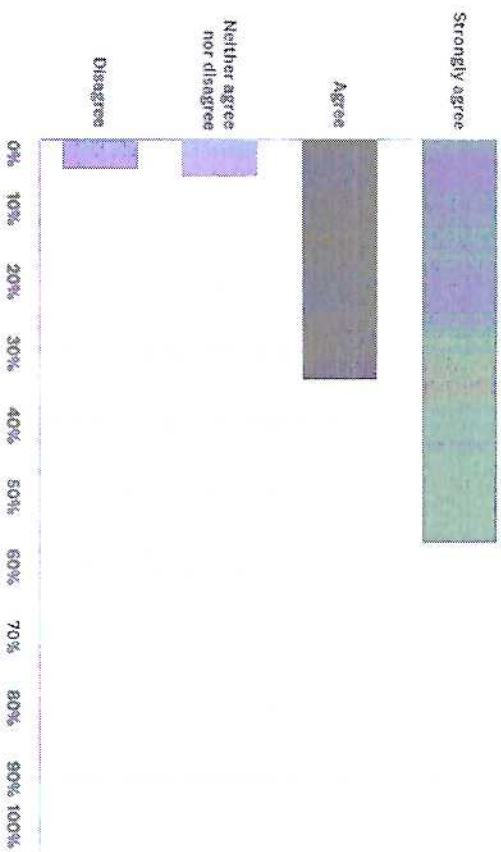

Q18 The City of Cape Coral Charter School System welcomes parents and family volunteers to actively become involved in school programs and activities.

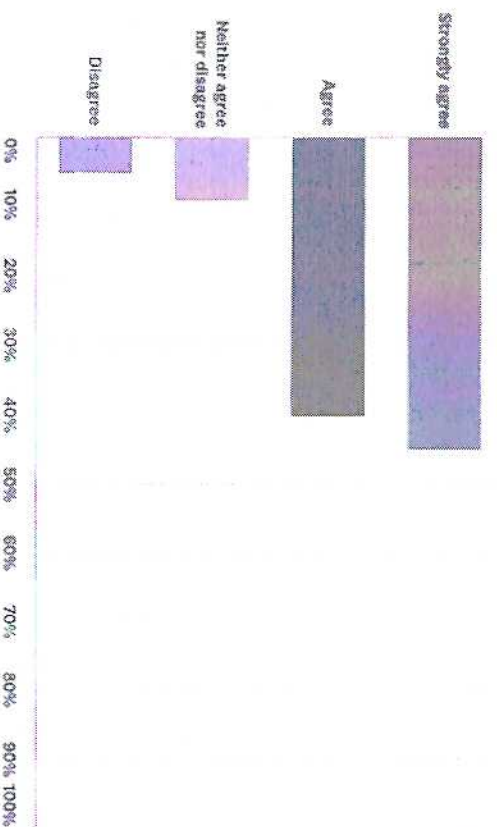
