


Our entire K-12 charter school system has been designated an FL Department of Education which ranks schools by student performance. "A" school system by the















Athletic Fields




- Renovation of existing football field proposal price \$134,000

- Matching grants for up to \$50,000 capital improvements (bleachers, lights, field house)






Q2 What is the likelihood that your child will matriculate through 12th grade in our school system?






